Wisconsin has a long-standing history and commitment to quality services for infants and toddlers with disabilities and their families. County agencies are key partners in the process and delivery of effective early intervention services in partnership with families and community providers.

OSEP requires states to enforce the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) by making local determinations under IDEA sections 616(b) and 642 annually on the performance of each early intervention program under Part C. States are required to consider a county Birth to 3 Program's performance on compliance Indicators 1, 7, 8, 9, valid, reliable and timely data, and audits when making determinations for the year July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. The State of Wisconsin and Washington County Birth to 3 Program determination statuses are listed below.
